

INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

1. The name of the federation is: **The Hatherley St James' Federation**
2. The names and categories of the schools in the federation are:

Name	Category
St James' C of E Junior School	Voluntary Controlled
Hatherley Infant School	Community

3. The name of the governing body is '**The governing body of The Hatherley St James' Federation**'
4. The governing body shall consist of
 - 2 parent governors
 - 1 LA governor
 - 1 staff governor
 - 1 headteacher
 - 2 foundation governors
 - 5 co-opted governors
5. Total number of governors: **12**
6. Foundation governors shall be appointed by Gloucester Diocesan Board of Education after consultation with the St James and All Saints and Christ Church Parochial Church Council.
- 7.

- (a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex officio:

The principal officiating minister of the ecclesiastical parish of St James and All Saints and Christ Church.

- (b) The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated shall, on behalf of Gloucester Diocesan Board of Education, be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of an ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that that ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or there is a vacancy in the office by virtue of which the governorship exists, or has been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Regulations.

8. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated shall, on behalf of Gloucester Diocesan Board of Education, be entitled to request the removal of any ex officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor.
9. A Trust exists which relates to St James' C of E Junior School, the Trustees being the Vicar and Church Wardens of All Saints and St James' Church.
10. Recognising its historic foundation, the Federation will enable and support St James' C of E Junior School to preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at Parish and Diocesan level.
11. This instrument comes into effect on 1st April 2023
12. This instrument was made by order of Gloucestershire County Council
on 30th day of March 2023.....
13. A copy of the instrument must be supplied free of charge to every member and associate member of the governing body (and the headteacher if not a governor), as well as, where relevant, the trustees of any foundation, the appropriate Diocesan authority and appropriate religious body.
